BULLITSCHEK FAMILY REUNION WILL BE HELD IN CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA JUNE 20-23, 2013

We will be staying at the newly opened Fairfield Inn at 605 32nd Avenue SW, Cedar Rapids. The phone number for making reservations is 319.247.1000. The room rate is \$89 for king size bed and \$99 for 2 queen beds. When making a reservation, please ask for the Bullitschek Family Reunion block of rooms. Reservations must be made by May 20th.

Each guest room has a mini refrigerator, coffeemaker, and iron. They offer a free hot breakfast with lots of options. There is complimentary wireless high-speed internet throughout the hotel. There is an indoor pool, whirlpool spa, and fitness center.

The reunion weekend will revolve around two major sights--the newly rebuilt National Czech & Slovak Museum and Library and the Amana Colonies. The National Czech & Slovak Museum tells the story of the Czech and Slovak people from the days of the Slovak tribes wandering into central Europe. This museum having been destroyed by the floods in 2008 was opened last summer. We will also be going to the Amana Colonies which is 17 miles from Cedar Rapids. The Amana Colonies have been a landmark in Iowa for over 150 years. We will see historical buildings dating from the 1850's covering German architectural styles and details of colonial America.

The tours and activities will take place on Friday and Saturday and a special lunch on Saturday will be held at the Ox Yoke Inn in Amana. Having toured both sights in December I am quite excited to have our reunion in Cedar Rapids!!!
