The family will have a Hospitality Room in The Valley View meeting room located on the third floor of the Branson Towers Hotel. As we register, they will put the Bolerjack Reunion registrants on the third floor near the Hospitality Room, unless an individual requests to be put elsewhere in the hotel. The Valley View Room is at the back of the hotel, at the opposite end to where we register. There is an elevator right there, and we can come and go out a back door if we prefer to park back there.

THURSDAY, JUNE 23, 2016, 4 - 6 PM, REGISTRATION:

Family members will be present in the Valley View Room to register the family members for the reunion, from 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, June 23, 2016 and continuously, except when there are activities that take us all way from the hotel.

6:00 PM. Bolerjack Reunion Dinner at Montana Mikes, 3225 Hwy 76. This restaurant is located about 3 miles from the Hotel. The menu is reasonable. Cheeseburgers from \$9, Dinner Salads from \$12, Children's menu. Full Steak Dinner from \$16, Deserts from \$5.

FRIDAY, JUNE 24, 2016.

Family members are invited to meet for breakfast at 8 AM in the hotel (which is included with the room). Or if you choose to eat at another time, breakfast is served from 6:30 AM until 9:30 AM. The whole day is unstructured until we join for dinner 5 PM. We suggest the following possibilities, but there are many others, in case you want to explore on your own. The Hospitality Room will include a write up of these activities in the Hospitality Room, which will detail the prices, a brief description, and location each activity. We have undertaken to identify plays that may be of interest, activities that we think the family would enjoy doing, and including some items particularly identified to be of interest to younger members of the family. Branson Landing is conveniently located on Branson Boulevard on Lake Taneycomo. It is a picturesque setting right next to Historic Downtown Branson. If you are interested in shopping, there are NUMEROUS factory outlets stores at the Landing. There is dining for any taste. There is a Fountain Show hourly fountain show. You can Ride the Ducks from there, as well. The Ducks ride through the Scenic Ozarks, climb to the top of the mountain and splashdown and cruise the lake. This is fun for all ages.

For younger family members and perhaps even the young at heart, there are activities that can be very exciting. For instance, there are Zip Rides and even Extreme Zip rides. If there are interests in these kinds of activities, and over 4 members want to do one, we can get group discounts. There are Go-Cart tracks and if there is an interest, we will be able to arrange races, and competitions within the family, perhaps even pitting the young go-getters against the old went-and-got them.

There are several options to see Branson Shows:

- *7:30 Shoji Tabuchi Show* - a glamorous, astounding start of the art variety production rivaling the excitement of Las Vegas or New York.
- *8:00 Legends in Concert* – this show features about ever star you ever wanted to see in person. They are very good impersonations, and some say better than the real people.
- *8:30 Shepherd of the Hills Outdoor Drama*. This is a tale of brave pioneers that lived in the Ozarks in the late 1800's and features horses, a shoot out, and the actual burning of a log cabin. The ending is very touching, and there probably will be a tear in your eye.

10:00 - 11:00 p.m. Ice Cream Social. There is an Ice Cream Social at the Branson Towers Hotel. There is piano music and room for family members to group as they listen to the Piano Music.
